



Isolation, identification, and characterization of the genus *Phytophthora*

2nd International workshop

The genus of *Phytophthora* belongs to Chromista and includes devastating pathogens of a large number of plants. Since a life form of this genus is similar to fungi, we have treated this group as fungus-like organisms (water mould).

This two-day workshop is given for Asian students to learn basic background information about the genus of *Phytophthora*. Participants obtain the necessary knowledge in the species-level taxonomy through lectures and hands-on experiences.
